

Kenneth B. Scott Scholarship

The Kenneth B. Scott Scholarship Fund was initiated in 2013 through the efforts of Peg Reiterman, Past Grand Matron, Grand Chapter of Ohio, OES, to recognize the dedicated efforts of Brother and Dad Ken Scott – as a Mason, a member of the Eastern Star, and as an advisor and supporter of Masonic Youth Groups. The scholarship is funded by donations from chapters and members of the Grand Chapter of Ohio, Order of the Eastern Star, and friends of Ken Scott. Ken is a senior DeMolay, Past Master Councilor and Past Governor of the 4th DeMolay District. He is a Past Master of New England Lodge #4 in Worthington, and served several times as Worthy Patron of Worthington Chapter #287, OES. He served as Worthy Grand Patron, Grand Chapter of Ohio, with WGM Peg Reiterman, in 2009. His three sons are senior DeMolays and his three daughters were all active in Rainbow at the state level, including one who served as Grand Worthy Advisor (Crissy Scott Willeke, 1990-91).

*A scholarship of up to \$1,000 (depending on available funding) will be awarded to a member of each of the Masonic Youth Groups in Ohio: DeMolay, Rainbow, and Job's Daughters. **The selection committee will evaluate applications on the basis of (1) participation in youth group activities, (2) academic excellence, and (3) financial need.***
